COOKIES ARE

The fugas.com website makes use of cookies. Cookies are "small text files" - made up of letters and numbers - "which sites visited by the user *send to the user's terminal (usually to the browser), where they are stored and then transmitted back to the same sites the next time the same user visits*".

Cookies have the function of streamlining web traffic analysis or signalling when a specific site or part of a site is visited, distinguishing between visitors in order to provide personalised content, and helping administrators to improve the site and the user's browsing experience.

Through cookies we cannot access any other information stored on your device, even if this is where the cookies are downloaded. Cookies cannot load codes of any kind, carry viruses or malware and are not harmful to your terminal equipment.

Below you can find all the information on the cookies installed through this site, and the necessary guidance on how to manage your preferences in this regard.

USER CONSENT

By connecting for the first time to any page of fugas.com, the user will see a brief information on the use of cookies. By closing this information using the appropriate button or clicking outside the banner that contains it and continuing to navigate, the user consents to our use of cookies, according to the modalities described in this Cookie Policy.

The site remembers the choice made by the user, so the short information will not be repeated in subsequent links from the same device. However, the user always has the possibility of revoking all or part of the consent already expressed.

WHAT TYPES OF COOKIES WE USE

In order to enable the use of our website and the provision of our services, we make use of both so-called persistent cookies (i.e. cookies that remain in the memory until manually deleted by the user or for which a long-term scheduled removal is planned) and so-called session cookies, which are not stored persistently on the visitor's computer and disappear when the browser is closed.

We use different types of cookies - with specific functions - which we can classify as follows:

First-party cookies, i.e. issued by Fugas.com

TECHNICAL (the user's consent is NOT required to issue this type of cookie).

- *Session and navigation*: these are indispensable for the proper functioning of our site and enable the user to navigate and view content. Their deactivation would lead to malfunctioning of the site. In general, cookies of this type are necessary, for example, to keep a browsing session open or to enable the user to access any restricted areas. Or they can temporarily remember texts entered while filling in a form, when returning to a previous page during the same session.

- *Functionality*: they allow the user to make the most of the site's features and enjoy more comfortable browsing. The site works ideally if these cookies are enabled; however, you can decide not to allow their activation on your device.
In general, for example, cookies of this type remember in which language the user prefers to view our content or remember (for a limited period) the items in the virtual shopping cart in the event that the session is closed before the purchase is completed.
- *Consent*: this cookie keeps track of the consent given by the user to the use of cookies on this site, so that on subsequent visits, the short cookie information and the request to give consent are not repeated.

Third-party cookies, i.e. issued by sites other than Fugas.com

STATISTICS (user consent is required to issue this type of cookie)

They are used to collect information on how users navigate our site. This information is analysed in aggregate form for statistical purposes only. They are not necessary, but are of great help to us to enable us to improve our content and services based on the information we obtain from the analysis of the statistics.

THIRD-PARTY COOKIES

By browsing this site you will receive both Fugas S.p.A. cookies and cookies from third party sites, which may set cookies on your device on our behalf in order to provide the services they are providing.

Third party cookies allow us to obtain more comprehensive surveys of your browsing habits. We use such cookies, for example, to collect information for advertising and content customization purposes, as well as to compile statistics about the use of our site and to gauge your interest in our specific content or services.

More detailed information on these cookies can be found in the following paragraphs in this document and on the respective websites of the third parties in question.

STATISTICS COOKIES (THIRD-PARTY)

Fugas.com uses Google Analytics, a web traffic analysis service provided by Google, Inc., 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway - Mountain View - CA94043 USA, which uses cookies to collect and analyse in aggregate form information relating to users' browsing. Nor Fugas S.p.A. nor Google will associate your IP address with other data in their possession in order to identify you directly.

The information collected is processed by Google Analytics systems for the purpose of producing reports for the administrators of fugas.com, who use it to verify the proper functioning of the services and, if necessary, the popularity rate of the proposed content.
